## **SPECIAL INTEREST VEHICLE REGISTRATION PROCESS**

The following process is provided by the EFCCQ for financial members of the Early Falcon Car Club of Queensland to make application to the Queensland Transport Department for Special Interest Vehicle Registration.

1. Any member wishing to apply for Special Interest Vehicle Registration must make application to the EFCCQ Executive Secretary.
2. Once the application is received and approved, the EFCCQ Executive Committee will authorise the EFCCQ Registration Officer to undertake a vehicle inspection and complete the official EFCCQ Special Interest Vehicle Registration form.
3. The EFCCQ Registration Officer is to retain the completed and signed Special Interest Vehicle Registration form and send it to the EFCCQ Secretary for lodging on the EFCCQ Member Database.
4. Once the form has been lodged and recorded on the EFCCQ Member Database, the member will receive an official EFCCQ Special Interest Vehicle Registration correspondence from the EFCCQ President.
5. This official EFCCQ Special Interest Vehicle Registration correspondence from the EFCCQ President must accompany their SIV application to Queensland Department of Transport and Main Roads.
6. Once the SIV application is approved by Queensland Department of Transport and Main Roads, the EFCCQ member must inform the EFCCQ of the approval and supply any new membership details for the EFCCQ Member Database, e.g. new registration number.
7. New members must be financial before Special Interest Vehicle Registration application can be made.
8. Members will undertake to abide by Queensland Transport and Main Road's guidelines for use of vehicles with Special Interest Vehicle Concessional Registration.



## 5. Eligibility requirements

Tick documentation provided (if applicable):

Current club membership with either an incorporated vehicle club/association or a vehicle club that is a public company limited by guarantee on club letterhead or official club documentation.

**Note:** A club membership card is not acceptable.

Certificate of membership with either an incorporated historical society or a certificate of Incorporation as an historical society with a recognised interest in vehicle heritage.

**Historic vehicles** – Certification from a dating officer/club official of the vehicle's authenticity and year of manufacturer on club letterhead or official club documentation

**Note:** This is only required if the date of manufacture cannot be verified by TMR (from an existing or previous vehicle record, import papers, or manufacturer's plate)

**Street rods and hot rods** – Certification from the Australian Street Rod Federation (ASRF) that the applicant is a current ASRF member and the vehicle was manufactured before 1949 or is a replica of a vehicle manufactured before 1949 on ASRF letterhead or official ASRF documentation.

## 6. Certification

I agree to inform TMR of any changes that may affect my eligibility to retain the concession within 14 days.

I acknowledge that the concession I am applying for is subject to conditions and agree to only use the vehicle in accordance with the conditions of the concession. For conditions, refer to the SIV guide located at [qld.gov.au/specialinterestrego](http://qld.gov.au/specialinterestrego).

I understand that if a vehicle on a concession is operated outside of the conditions of the concession, a fine may be issued, the concession may be withdrawn, and the full registration fee may become payable.

I consent to TMR verifying my EOI documents or information with the issuing authority or their agencies. I certify that the information and statements provided in this application are true and correct.
